

## **Cagle Law Firm Big Brothers Big Sisters Scholarship**

**ELIGIBILITY:** Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Recipient is a U.S. citizen or otherwise authorized to work in the United States
- Recipient is accepted, and will be attending undergraduate school in the fall of the same year following the application.
- Academic achievement as reflected by an undergraduate cumulative minimum 2.5 GPA
- Applicants must fulfil one of the following:
  - Graduating High School Seniors currently in an active matches and planning to attend a qualifying school/program.
  - Big Futures matches – active match with student 18 years or older and attending a qualifying school/program
  - Any past Little planning to attend a qualifying school/program.

**REQUIREMENTS:** Applicants must submit the following by July 1st, 2018:

- A completed Scholarship Application Form
- One to three (1-3) page typed essay
  - An official and complete copy of high school or undergraduate college transcripts
- An acceptance letter from an accredited university within the United States
- Proof of legal residency in the U.S. (i.e., birth certificate, passport, permanent resident card, etc.)

**AWARD :**

- Cagle Law Firm BBBS scholarship is to be used exclusively for school tuition and related expenses.
- A check for \$1,000 will be made payable to the award recipient's school to cover these expenses.
- Recipient is expected to submit receipts in accordance with IRS regulations.
- Cagle Law Firm BBBS Scholarship award recipient will be notified of the selection on or about August 1, 2018.
